








PREFIXES	MEANING	EXAMPLE
BIO- 	LIFE	BIOLOGY: the study of living things
CARCIN- 	PERTAINING TO CANCER	CARCINOGEN: any substance or agent that tends to produce a cancer.
CARDI- 	PERTAINING TO THE HEART	CARDIOVASCULAR DISEASE: a class of diseases that involve the heart or blood vessels.
DYS- 	BAD OR DIFFICULT	DYSPHASIA: is a partial or complete impairment of the ability to communicate resulting from brain injury.
DERM- 	PERTAINING TO THE SKIN	DERMATITIS: a disease in which the skin is red and painful.
FACI- 	PERTAINING TO THE FACE	FACIOPLEGIA: paresis or paralysis of the facial muscles.
GASTRO- 	PERTAINING TO THE STOMACH	GASTROENTEROLOGY: the branch of medicine focused on the digestive system and its disorders.
